


The facts:

- The City Board founded the Neighbourhood Project in 1996
- The Neighbourhood Project is subordinate to the City Board and reports annually to the City Board.
- Project is a collaborative project between the departments of the City, which works in the suburban areas
- The steering group of the Neighbourhood Project has 17 members from 12 departments. The Chairman for the 2016–2017 period is Rikhard Manninen, Head of the Strategic Planning Division at the City Planning Department.
- Broad and long-term work is undertaken to <u>prevent</u> <u>inequality</u> and <u>poor image</u> in the suburban areas.

Regeneration areas project, City planning department Densification of the neigbourhood Areal Plan


- Larger variety of different housing typologies and sizes of flats

- First physical footstep giving an image of the large scale changes that are about to come













